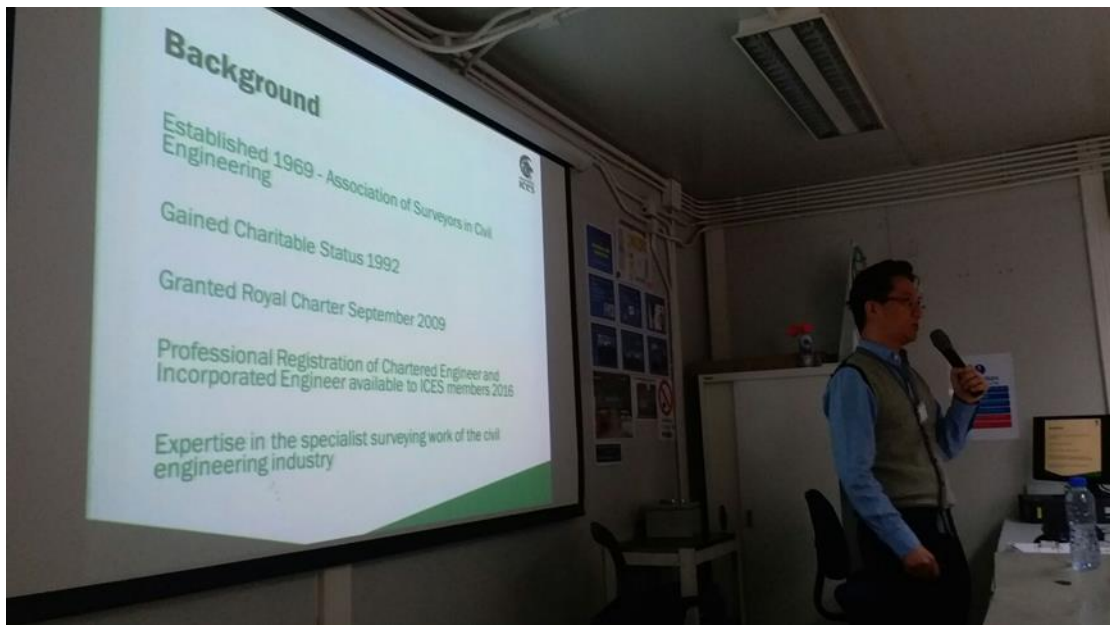
Joint the Hong Kong Polytechnic University Education Information Day to promote the institution and membership to potential students

澳大工料測量課四十六人畢業

【本報消息】澳門大學持續進修中心日前為第三、四期“工料測量專業文憑課程”舉行畢業典禮，向四十六名學員頒發文憑，同時學員亦獲英國皇家特許土木工程測量師學會專業認證，有助澳門建築工程業界自我提升及與國際接軌。

典禮上，澳門建築置業商會會長劉永誠致辭表示，澳門建築業發展關注小組自第一期開始，聯同澳大持續進修中心及英國皇家特許土木工程測量師學會攜手組織支持施工人員專業發展的工料測量課程，在提高本地建築業人才競爭力方面不遺餘力。不知不覺已為業界培養了不少工料測量專業的人才，相信隨着課程開辦後，業界中的人才不管在質與量上也越趨優化。作為建築專業人士，必須持續學習，吸收新知識，並繼續支持業界不斷自我提升。

The project involves the construction of a 300 metre long tunnel and the approach road to the tunnel at North Point, modification works at existing roads and associated works such as noise barriers, road & drainage works and landscaping. The project was briefly presented by AECOM, the consulting engineer team. Following the presentation was the site walk led by the contractor to the works areas to realize the related site activities.
